WIIH Impact Goals

The number of women receiving 6 or more prenatal visits

The number of women using substances illicitly during pregnancy

Universal SBIRT screening done at first prenatal visit

Reporting SUD in pregnancy consistently between provider sites

Family planning counseling conducted with all WIIH patients

What Wrapped in Hope CAN Do

- Advocacy
- Coordinated, Compassionate and Non-Judgmental Care
- Referrals to Home Visiting
- Access to Family Planning
- Chemical Dependency Assessments
- Referrals to Appropriate Services (may include higher levels of care or social service supports)
- 30 Minute to 1 Hour Therapy Appointments
- Scheduled Case Management Appointments
- Limited Crisis Stabilization/Support

What Wrapped in Hope CAN'T Do

- Mandate Services
- Groups
- 24/7 Transportation
- Intensive Chemical Dependency Treatment
- Financial Assistance
- Ensure Compliance with CPS/Probation/Parole Requirements

Wrapped in Hope Menu of Services



Therapeutic Outpatient Services

30 minute to 1-hour therapy appointments with engaged patients

Coordinated Care with a Team of Providers

Primary Care Providers, Medication Assisted Therapy (MAT) Team, OB Providers, Behavioral Health Providers, Nurses and Support Staff

CPS, mental health agencies, public defenders, drug court, prosecutor's office, reentry, probation and parole

Chemical Dependency Evaluations & Integrated Mental Health Assessments

Integrated mental health and chemical dependency evaluations

Case Management Support

Scheduled case management appointments to assist with applications, referrals, advocacy, follow up and encouragement/coaching

Crisis Stabilization/ Support

A counselor may offer after hours phone coaching via the WIH phone on a case by case basis
