This document constitutes an agreement between Missouri River Medical Center (MRMC)/Benton Medical Center (BMC) and the Chouteau County Health Department (CCHD).

Background:

If an event, either natural or man-made, occurs in Chouteau County the following guidelines may be activated. If the event requires mass prophylaxis/immunization or isolation and quarantine, Missouri River Medical Center/Benton Medical Center agrees to assist in the disposal of waste management. This includes but is not limited to: all protective clothing worn by specimen collector and/or infected individual (gloves, mask, gowns etc.) and all specimen collection materials (sharps, sharps containers, biohazard material) which must be placed in red biohazard bags and autoclaved or incinerated prior to disposal. Also, MRMC/BMC agrees to provide laundry services should we need to isolate and quarantine.

The Chouteau County Health Department would notify MRMC/BMC of the need at outbreak of the event or any time throughout the event when assistance is warranted.

Purpose:

To provide biohazard waste disposal and laundry services during and emergency or event.

Responsibilities:

- A. Chouteau County Health Department
 - 1. Responsible to notify MRMC/BMC of the situation and need for assistance.
 - 2. MRMC/BMC staff will be briefed on appropriate waste management, laundering protocol, and duties required.
 - 3. Will provide emergency contact number to call for information.
 - 4. Will provide logistical information as to supplies, personnel needed, and transportation of supplies to and from sites.

B. MRMC/BMC

- 1. Will provide 24/7 contact numbers to CCHD in case of an event.
- 2. Will provide staff, as able to respond to need when requested.
- 3. Staff will report to CEO or DON who in turn will report to IC or Health Officer.
- 4. Staff will function under the current EOP, which contains the CC Emergency Preparedness Response Plan.

Compensation:

It is understood that if such an event occurred that would require activation of this agreement, a disaster situation would have been declared at least within the local jurisdiction and/or the state, thus making costs incurred eligible for reimbursement from state and/or federal resources.
